REFERENCE SCRIPTURE(S)

Proverbs 11:24-25, Luke 6:38, Galatians 6:7-9

HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS

Paul had a specific reason for penning chapters 8 & 9 of 2 Corinthians. The mother church, which was in Jerusalem had fallen on rough times. Unable to help themselves because of economic strain in the Jewish economy, the Christians faced a bleak future. In 1 Corinthians 16:1-4, Paul instructed the Corinthian believers to set aside a portion of their income on the first day of the week for this collection. He emphasized the importance of this act of giving to support the saints in Jerusalem who were experiencing hardship. Further, in 2 Corinthians 8-9, Paul discusses the collection of the saints in Jerusalem and encourages the Corinthians to excel in the grace of giving.
